TODAY'S READINGS Year A

First Reading — You shall be my special possession, dearer to me than all others (Exodus 19:2-6a).

Psalm — We are the people of the Lord, his flock. (Psalm 100:1-2,3,5)

Second Reading — We boast of God through Christ Jesus, though whom we have been reconciled (Romans 5:6-11).

Gospel — Jesus commissioned the Twelve: Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. (Matthew 9:36 — 10:8)

LABORERS NEEDED

Today's scriptures employ mixed metaphors—images of sheep and shepherds, priests and people, harvest and laborers—all of which intermingle to create a web of meaning on which we have based our understanding of Christian vocations. Above all, these images help us see Jesus' own ministry in the world. They lend themselves especially well to a reflection on the vocation to ordained priesthood. The scriptures for today help us understand the role of the ordained in the life of the Church. They also encourage us to pray for an increase in the number of candidates for priestly ordination, for "the harvest is abundant but the laborers are few" (Matthew 9:37).
